Last week SnapChat, used regularly by many children and young people, launched a new feature – SnapMaps. This allows users to see the location of other users. This means it allows others to accurately pinpoint where you are. There are three possible privacy settings:

- Ghost mode, where only you can see your position;
- My Friends mode, where any contact can see your location; and
- Select Friends mode, just those who you choose can see you

It has obviously been flagged up as a concern that a child's location can be made available to others. If you have children who use this feature we recommend that the settings are set to Ghost mode.
