

Understanding English, communication and languages:

We will write our own version of an adventure story using the wordless picture book, Journey by Aaron Becker. We will be focusing on these aspects of grammar and punctuation:

- Use the present perfect form of verbs in contrast to the past tense
- Use prepositions, conjunctions and adverbs to express time, place and cause
- Group related ideas into paragraphs
- Use a or an according to whether the next word begins with a vowel or a consonant

Mathematical understanding

Fractions

- Recognise unit and non-unit fractions
- Recognise different fractions
- Find fractions of amounts
- Find equivalent fractions

Money

- Add and subtract amounts of money to give change, using both £ and p in practical contexts.

Scientific and technological understanding

Plants:

We will continue with our plant topic, developing our scientific enquiry skills around this topic.

- Explore the part that flowers play in the life cycle of flowering plants, including pollination, seed formation and seed dispersal.
- Explain the requirements of plants for life and growth (air, light, water, nutrients from soil, room to grow) and how they vary from plant to plant.
- Know the way in which water is transported within plants.
