Adventures at St Joseph's

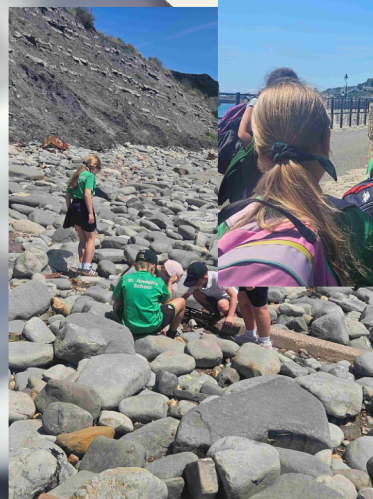


Choir

We learnt all about Mary Anning and her amazing geological work. We then went on a fossil hunting walk on the same beach where Anning made her discoveries.



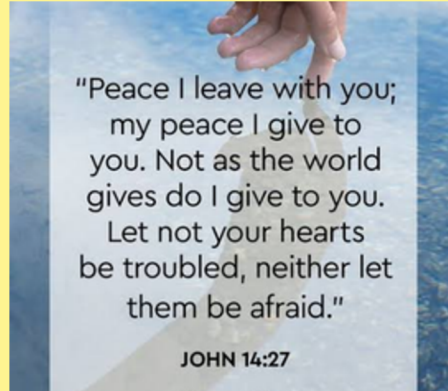
