Jubilee Day – Thursday 26th May

Next Thursday 26th May, we will be having our special Jubilee day. We are asking that children come in wearing Red, White and Blue and bring a party packed lunch which we plan to eat together outdoors. We are also going to have a special Jubilee 'St Joseph's Bake off' cake competition and cake sale at 3.30pm that day. For this we are asking people to bake and send in cakes which will be judged by 'The Queen' and there will be a prize for the winner. All cakes will then be for sale in the hall where there will also be an 'art gallery' display of the children's portraits of the Queen they will have completed over the week.

What3words app

On Friday the children from yr 2 – 6 had a talk by the fire service. They spoke to the older children about the What3words app. This is a free app that children can download on their phone so if they ever need to ring 999 they can look on What3words and it gives them 3 words to say to the emergency services which allows them to pinpoint their location to within a metre. It covers the whole globe so if they are lost in woods or on a river it still gives their exact location.

I also spoke to the Yr 6s about making sure that they and their families have an app such as Find My iPhone which allows parents and guardians to see exactly where they are. Again this is useful so parents can check the children are walking home safely, collect them if they are lost etc.
