I am sure you will understand this is to safeguard you as well as our children.

Fruit and veg

We are a healthy, nut, free school. If you are sending your child in with a snack for play time it must be fruit or vegetables. Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 receive a free fruit snack each day.

Attendance

I have had a large amount of holiday requests coming in this week. This is a reminder that we do not authorise holidays during term time. If your child has more than 5 days unauthorised it automatically gets sent to County. Potentially you can then get fined. If you do not pay the fine within 21 days the fine doubles, if that is not paid within a week it goes through to legal proceedings.
