Share an inspiring story about growing a forest in a town with no nature to enjoy. Then plant your own tree seed and take it home to grow on. **4-10 years**



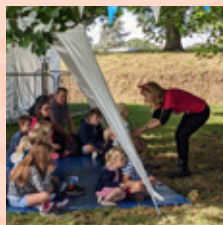
Cat Weatherill *Storytelling*
