Understanding English, communication and languages:

We will use the book a Star in a Jar to inspire us in our narrative writing. We will use our sentence stacking lessons to improve our sentence structures and we will learn how to create plot points throughout the story.

We will learn the features needed to create a set of instructions and how we create sentence structures to create this type of writing.

Scientific and technological understanding Forces and Magnets

We will:

- Compare how things move on different surfaces
- Notice that some forces need contact between 2 objects, but magnetic forces can act at a distance
- Observe how magnets attract or repel each other and attract some materials and not others
- Compare and group together a variety of everyday materials on the basis of whether they are attracted to a magnet, and identify some magnetic materials
- Describe magnets as having 2 poles

RE:

Together—We will focus on the Eucharist and what happens at each part of the mass.

Giving—We will learn about how Lent is a time of giving and how we can show this in our everyday lives.

Mathematical understanding Multiplication and Division

- Recognise that groups are not equal and learn the 3,4, and 8 times tables.
