Dear Parents and Carers,

As you will be aware we had to close our Reception and Nursery bubble yesterday due to a positive Lateral Flow test. Fortunately, the PCR test came back negative so we were able to open again today.

There are still a growing number of cases in the community and with the 10 day isolation period in place it is starting to affect staffing, both at school and then in local businesses when parents have to take time off to isolate for themselves or their children. Early identification is still key to reducing transmission so please ensure you isolate and book a PCR test at a test site as soon as any symptoms start. Everyone is also entitled to the free lateral flow tests. These are key for picking up positive cases where there are no symptoms present. They can be collected from the Maer carpark or ordered online.
