## What to do if your child tests positive for Covid over the Christmas holidays

I wanted to make you aware of the procedures for notifying the school if your child tests positive for Covid over the holidays. These procedures will help us all to safeguard and protect school and community members over the holiday period.

If your child tests positive between 19<sup>th</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup> December, please contact the school at <a href="mailto:admin@stjo.uk">admin@stjo.uk</a>. We will then contact you and Public Health. After speaking to Public Health we will then contact any staff and parents of children who have to then self-isolate.

Friday 11 <sup>th</sup> – Friday 18 <sup>th</sup> December	Do not bring your child to school if they have any Covid
	symptoms. You should then book for your child to have
	a test. Notify the school as soon as you receive the test
	result.
	Do not bring your child into school if anyone in your
	support bubble/household develops symptoms or has a
	positive test result.
Saturday 19 <sup>th</sup> December	If your child develops symptoms please inform the
Sunday 20 <sup>th</sup> December	school on admin@stjo.uk
	You should book for your child to get a test asap.
	The school will then contact you.
Monday 21 <sup>st</sup> – Thursday 24 <sup>th</sup> December	If your child receives a positive test result in this time
	please contact admin@stjo.uk
	We will then speak with you and Public Health and
	inform any school members who need to self-isolate.
Friday 25 <sup>th</sup> December – Sunday 3 <sup>rd</sup> January	If your child tests positive during this time, please isolate
	and the Track and Trace system will work with you to
	identify close contacts.
	Please contact the school at <a href="mailto:admin@stjo.uk">admin@stjo.uk</a> and let us
	know the date of the positive test but we will not need
	to contact you during the holidays.
Monday 4 <sup>th</sup> January	Start of term
	If anybody in your household or support bubble has
	symptoms of Covid or has tested positive in the last 14
	days do not send your child to school.
	Please ring and speak to the office 01395 264875

The final day of term is Friday 18<sup>th</sup> December. The above procedures are to safeguard our community; your support will, as always, be much appreciated.
