## Dear all,

The children have had a fantastic week. They looked super today and they were definitely smiling with what they were wearing. Thank you for all the money that has been sent in and many thanks to Jasmyne and Amelie for making and selling the pompoms. They raised an amazing £44.72. Also this week we have had workshops running across school with some really important messages. BigFoot Arts came in on Wednesday and ran the Anti-bullying workshops for all classes. The younger children learnt about using kind words, liking ourselves, having a thinking brain and a loving heart. The older children learnt about different types of bullying, including cyber bullying and racism. Through drama they explored what it means and how the people involved would have felt and the after effects.

Yesterday FSU and Maple and Beech classes had their environmental workshops.

Beech and Maple classes learnt about the problems plastic pollution causes the marine environment. The children learnt about micro-plastics and made their own hand scrubs which don't contain any plastic. They then made posters to persuade others not to buy scrubs containing microbeads.

Foundation Stage learnt about being 'Plastic Pirates!' Using toy animals, they explored how animals like sea turtles get trapped in plastic and birds end up with plastic in their nests. They made wooden medallions to remind them to 'reduce, reuse, recycle'. The leader said 'the children were 'the best FSU she had ever worked with!' Well done to our children.
