St Joseph's Wreath challenge



Whilst Christmas may seem far away, I'm sure it will be here before we know it!

This year we are asking that all the children have a go at 'creating' their own Advent wreath. These will then be displayed around school for all the children to see in the last weeks of term. We will be selecting a winner from FSU and Key Stage 1 and a winner from Key Stage 2.

So the challenge:

All children are asked to design and make their own wreath. This could be out of leaves, paper, cardboard, lego, clay etc the more creative the better.

I have included some examples below as inspiration and an idea from CAFOD but like it says above, you can be as creative as you like! Please make it rather than just draw it. All we ask if that your Advent Wreath shows the symbolization of the Advent Wreath so that it is a circle, has 5 candles 3 purple, 1 pink and 1 white candle.



I would be grateful if the children could bring their wreaths into school by Monday 6^{th} December so that there is plenty of time for them to be viewed and enjoyed. Please can you ensure that your child's name and class are clearly on your entry.
