South West Water work

From 8th December – 18th December SWW are closing Long Causeway between the junction with Regents Gate and Boarden Barn/Raddenstile Lane. Pedestrian access will still be open but vehicle access will only be open from Claremont Grove down to Regents Gate and then closed off just past the junction.
