### Covid

We have had notice from Devon and CAST that due to the number of cases in the area we have had to go back to online assemblies and reducing the amount of mixing across classes inside school. At the moment we are still keeping to mixing at lunch and break time due to staffing but we will continue to monitor the situation. We have had a staff member and a child test positive this week. Staff are continuing to do lateral flow tests and I know many families are as well which is great. The tests are free and can be collected from Maer carpark (was closed due to storm damage) or ordered from <a href="https://www.gov.uk/order-coronavirus-rapid-lateral-flow-tests">https://www.gov.uk/order-coronavirus-rapid-lateral-flow-tests</a>. The lateral flow tests are just for when there are no symptoms present. If there are any symptoms — a temperature, cough or loss of taste or smell, a PCR test must be done at a test centre.

We have had a number of children and staff off unwell – non Covid related. This is the same for all schools at the moment and supply agencies are also struggling to have enough staff to cover the absences. Please bear with us. If your child has a different teacher or teaching assistant this is unavoidable and we are doing the very best we can

#### **Breakfast and After School Club**

Due to the large number of children now attending we have had to cap the numbers to meet staff/child ratios. It is important that you book a place 3 days in advance. If you do not book 3 days in advance you need to ring us. If we have space then we will book your child in but as happened this week if the club is already full then unfortunately you will not be able to book your child in.
