Dear Parents and Carers,

The children in KS2 really enjoyed the workshops run by CAP UK (Child Assault Prevention) this week. The workshops took a fresh approach to assault prevention, aiming to reduce fear by focusing on what children can do, rather than on what they can't. The workshops were designed to build children's confidence and self-esteem. The children learnt through drama and discussion with trained facilitators, about their rights to safety, strength and freedom. They encouraged them to be proud of these rights and to respect the rights of others. Through the workshops they learnt that they have the ability to protect themselves in unsafe situations.

Government guidance

As we approach the next stage of the National Road Map, we have been issued updated guidance from the government on steps that schools should be taking. For Primary schools, there is to be no change to the way in which we operate and we are to maintain all the measures such as staggered starts, good hand hygiene, good ventilation and bubbles. Unfortunately, this means we are still unable to open up and invite parents in yet.

In the meantime, please support us all by ensuring that if your child has any symptoms of COVID that they get a PCR test not a Lateral Flow test.

The food bank is available and can provide weekly parcels to families.
