<u>Understanding English, communication and languages:</u>

Poetry:

Children will have opportunities to write and perform their own list poems about themselves.

Narrative:

We will use the story the Papaya that spoke and explore the vocabulary and patterned language used to create our own versions.

Scientific and technological understanding

We will learn that animals, including humans, have offspring which grow into adults and we will describe the basic needs of animals and humans for survival (water, food and air).

We will describe the importance for humans of exercise, eating the right amounts of different types of food and hygiene.

RE:

Creation

This unit is designed to give some insight into the stories and characters of the Old Testament. It will build on their knowledge of God as creator and start to provide an image of God wishing to protect and care for His universe. This unit is designed to develop children's appreciation of themselves and the world around them as part of God's creation.

Prayers, Saints and Feasts

Children will be able to develop an understanding of why the Church has saints.

Computing

Computing will be taught by Mrs Greenway this term. The Unit is, 'You've Got Mail' and this unit will explore the use of email and the children will have the opportunity to send an email. As part of this, they will learn the importance of using technology safely and respectfully, keeping personal information private and to identify where to go for help and support when they have concerns about content or contact on the internet or other online technologies.
